

About the Away From Home Haemodialysis (AFHH) program

The Away From Home Haemodialysis (AFHH) program provides eligible NSW residents requiring haemodialysis treatment with up to three (3) fully funded sessions per calendar year at participating private dialysis units across Australia while on holidays.

Enjoy the flexibility of travelling within NSW or interstate for any reason, including visiting family and friends or enjoying a short holiday, while still receiving this life-saving treatment.

Checking your eligibility is quick and easy

Our online Eligibility Tracker can determine if you may be eligible for this program within minutes. Scan the QR code on the back of this brochure or visit our website.



If you are eligible, you can access up to three (3) fully funded sessions per calendar year at participating private dialysis units across Australia while on holidays, which you can book up to three (3) months in advance.



The application process is simple

1. Check your eligibility using the steps above.
2. Contact the private dialysis unit(s) you are planning on travelling to and check availability for your desired sessions/dates. A list of participating private dialysis units is available on the website.
3. Fill out the AFHH application form either digitally or manually, which you can find on our website. The information you provide will be used to confirm your eligibility for the program.
4. Your preferred travel dates will be sent to the nominated dialysis unit(s). If your travel dates have been accepted, the AFHH team will send you a confirmation letter.
5. The receiving dialysis unit(s) will contact you directly to discuss the criteria you need to meet before you arrive for your scheduled appointments.
